

RoHS Compliance

Directive (2011/65/EU)

The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) Directive (2011/65/EU) was transposed into UK law on 2 January 2013.

This legislation bans the placing on the EU market of new EEE containing more than the agreed levels of Lead (Pb), Cadmium (Cd), Mercury (Hg), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+), Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) and Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE).

Metamark manufactured products are compliant with RoHS. These products do not contain substances above the ceiling concentration in outlined in Annex II of the directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS directive: June 8, 2011).
